VI. Prizes:

(1) Individual Prizes:

- i) **Buddha's Light Award:** NT\$8,000, a certificate and prize (totals 5 divisions/1 winner per division)
- ii) **Distinction Award:** NT\$6,000, a certificate and prize (totals 5 divisions/1 winner per division)
- iii) **Outstanding Award:** NT\$3,000, a certificate and prize (totals 5 divisions/1 winner per division)
- iv) **Excellence Award:** NT\$1,000, a certificate and prize (totals 5 divisions/20 winner per division)

- v) **Honorable Mention:** A certificate and prize (depending on the number of entries)

(2) Group Prizes:

Certificates (for three groups with the most winners)

(3) Winning artworks will be selected for international touring exhibitions.

VII. Requirements of Artworks

- (1) **Dimensions:** 39 cm x 54 cm (4K/framing not required)
- (2) **Medium:** No restriction on medium used for painting. All artwork must be created by the student participant personally. One entry per participant.

 - (3) Participant should not ask third party to make the artwork on his/her behalf, receive help from third party while drawing, or commit plagiarism by copying or imitating others' artworks. Violators will be disqualified or declared ineligible for winning.
 - (4) All participating entries are non-returnable; ownership and copyrights of all entries belong to F.G.S. Foundation for Buddhist Culture and Education.
 - (5) Tax amount of the prize money will be deducted according to the tax law of the Republic of China prior to handing over to the winners.
